

Sample Itinerary 2 ARRIVING FROM THE SOUTH

Day 1

11.00am Arrive at Foxglove Spire Gardens in Tilba Tilba. Stroll through this 3.5 acre romantic woodland garden. Time to browse in the nursery and gift shops.

12.30pm Arrive Central Tilba. Passengers have two hours to explore this National Trust village and its specialty shops, as well as having lunch at one of the village's cafes.

2.30pm Depart Central Tilba and travel to Tilba Valley Wines. Learn about local wine production and sample a glass or two. Cellar door sales available.

3.45pm Rejoin the Princes Highway to travel to Narooma. Check into accommodation. Rest before dinner.

6.00pm Coach to Narooma Services Club or Narooma Golf Club for evening meal, or try one of Narooma's restaurants.

Day 2

8.00am Breakfast at accommodation and check out.

9.00am Board coach and travel to Narooma Bar Lookout for spectacular views to Montague Island.

9.30am Reboard coach for Narooma Visitor Centre to inspect the Lighthouse Museum, a display dedicated to the Montague Island lighthouse and the history of the island.

10.15am Board the Wagonga Princess for a leisurely cruise on Wagonga Inlet. Skipper Charlie tells the history of the inlet and the town, and a few tall stories. Billy tea and scones served for morning tea.

12noon Depart Narooma for Tuross Head.

12.30pm Stop at the Pickled Octopus for lunch, with views up the Tuross River and of the boatshed activities.

1.30pm Depart Tuross Head and travel to Moruya, taking in the heritage buildings and the Historical Society Museum.

3.00pm Depart Moruya and travel to Mogo Zoo, home of rare and endangered species.

5.00pm Depart Mogo and travel to Batemans Bay via the coast road. Check into overnight accommodation and rest before dinner.

6.00pm Coach departs for dinner at Catalina Country Club, or try one of Batemans Bay's many restaurants.

Day 3

8.00am Breakfast at accommodation and check out.

9.15am Travel via the Princes Highway to the Eurobodalla Native Botanic Gardens for a guided tour.

10.30am Return to Batemans Bay town wharf to embark on a Clyde River luncheon cruise. The boat cruises upriver as far as Nelligen and returns to Batemans Bay.

2.00pm Board coach to travel north. Call into Norma Holt Studio Gallery where the artist is at work using oils, pastels and watercolours. Or perhaps visit Alleycat Arthaven, Longbeach – a gallery featuring the work of many talented local artists.

2.30pm Depart the Eurobodalla Coast for overnight accommodation in the Shoalhaven region. Call in at Pebbly Beach or Depot Beach to see kangaroos on the beach (entry and exit the National Park via Mt Agony Road is recommended).
